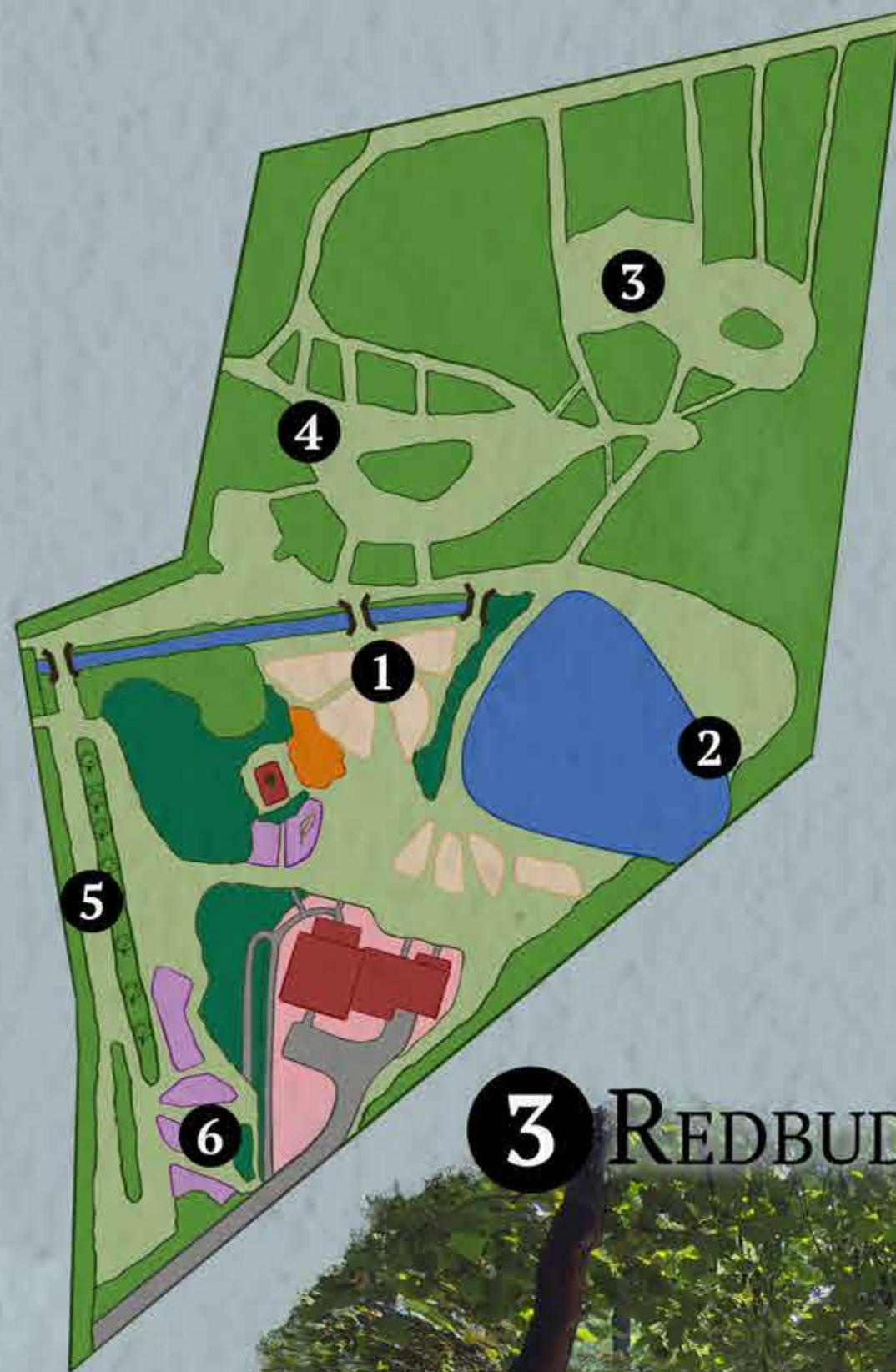

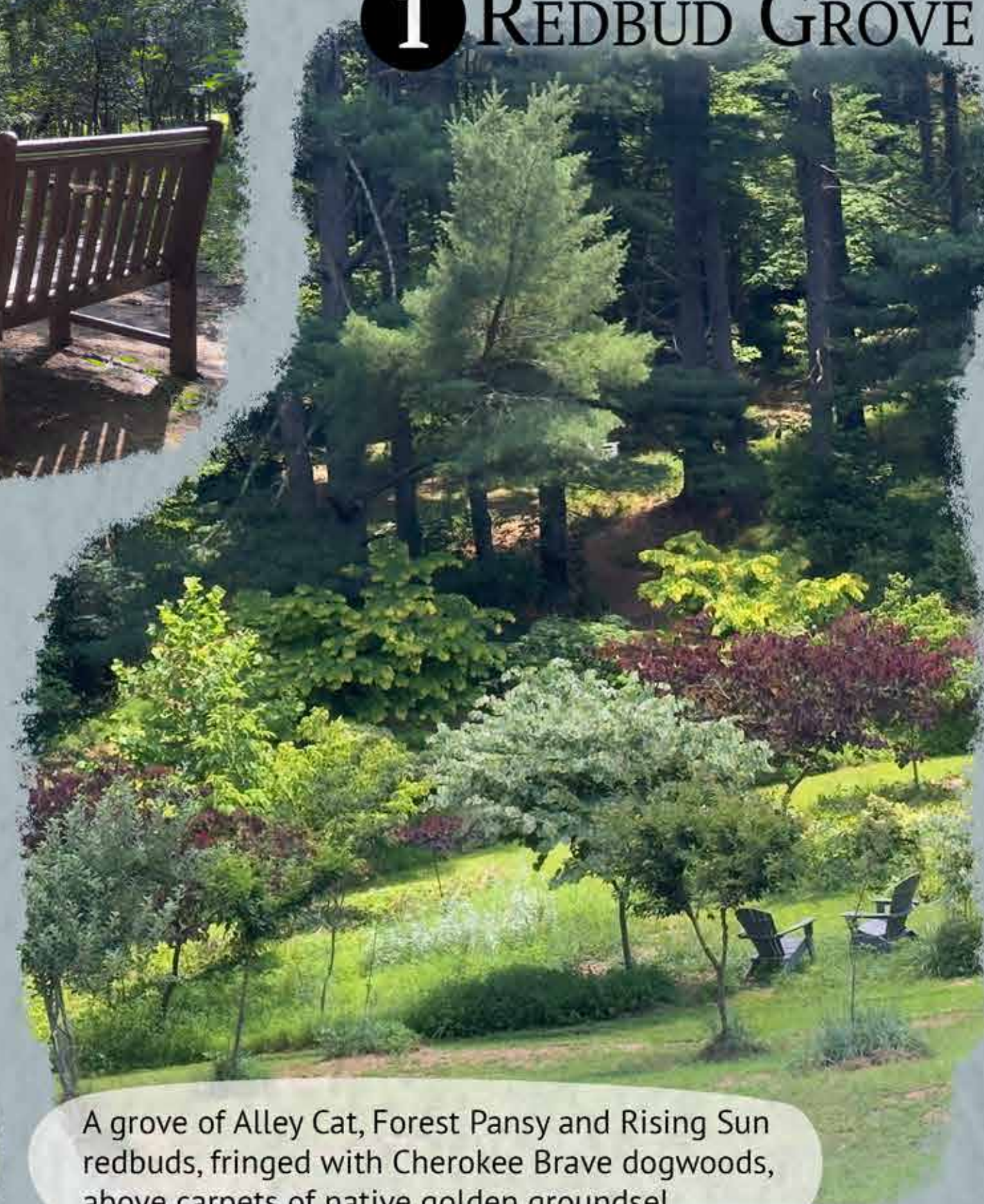


4 FOREST TRAILS

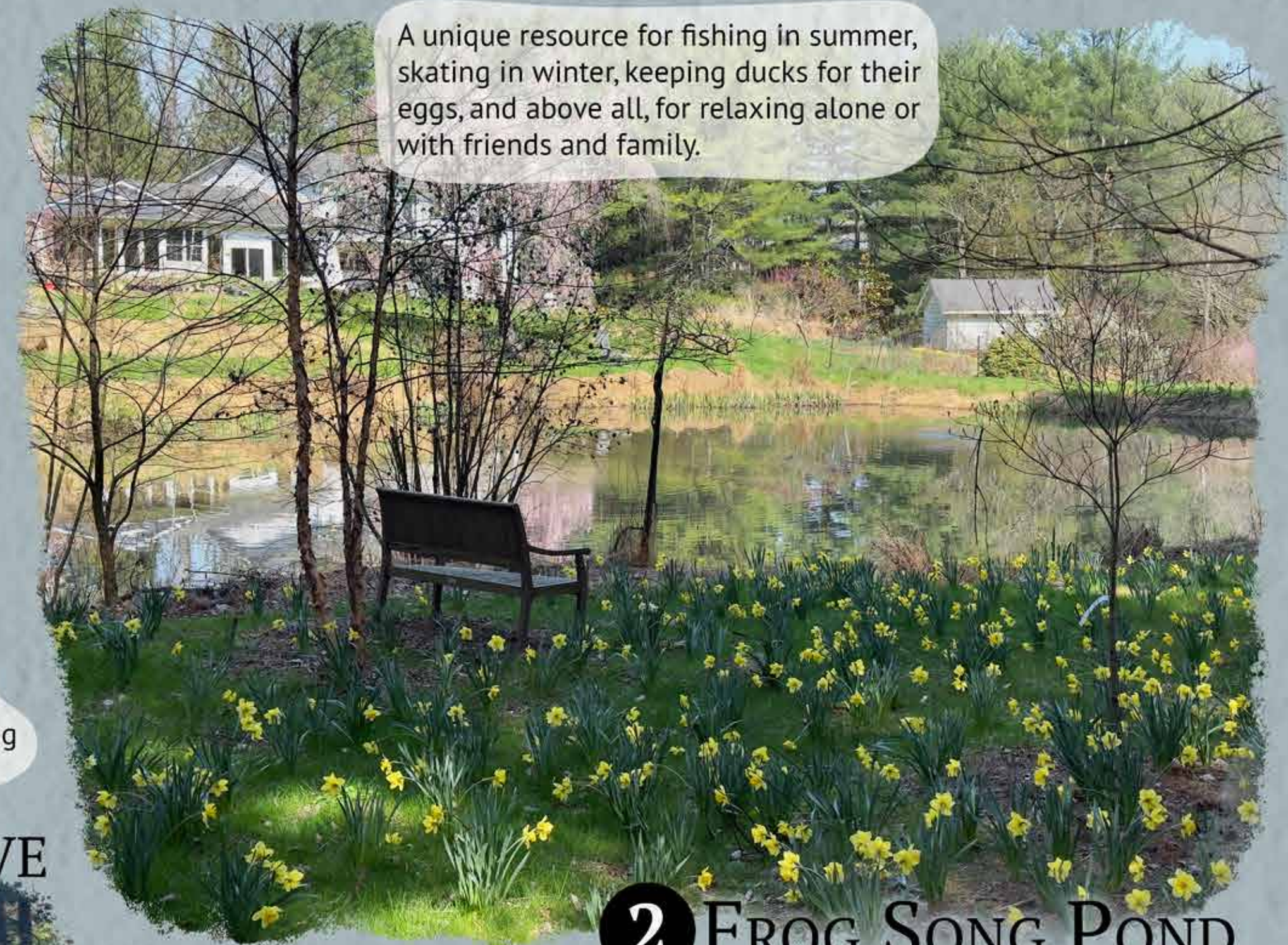


Your own private forest with numerous trails for hiking, meditating, running, and getting back in touch with nature.

1 REDBUD GROVE

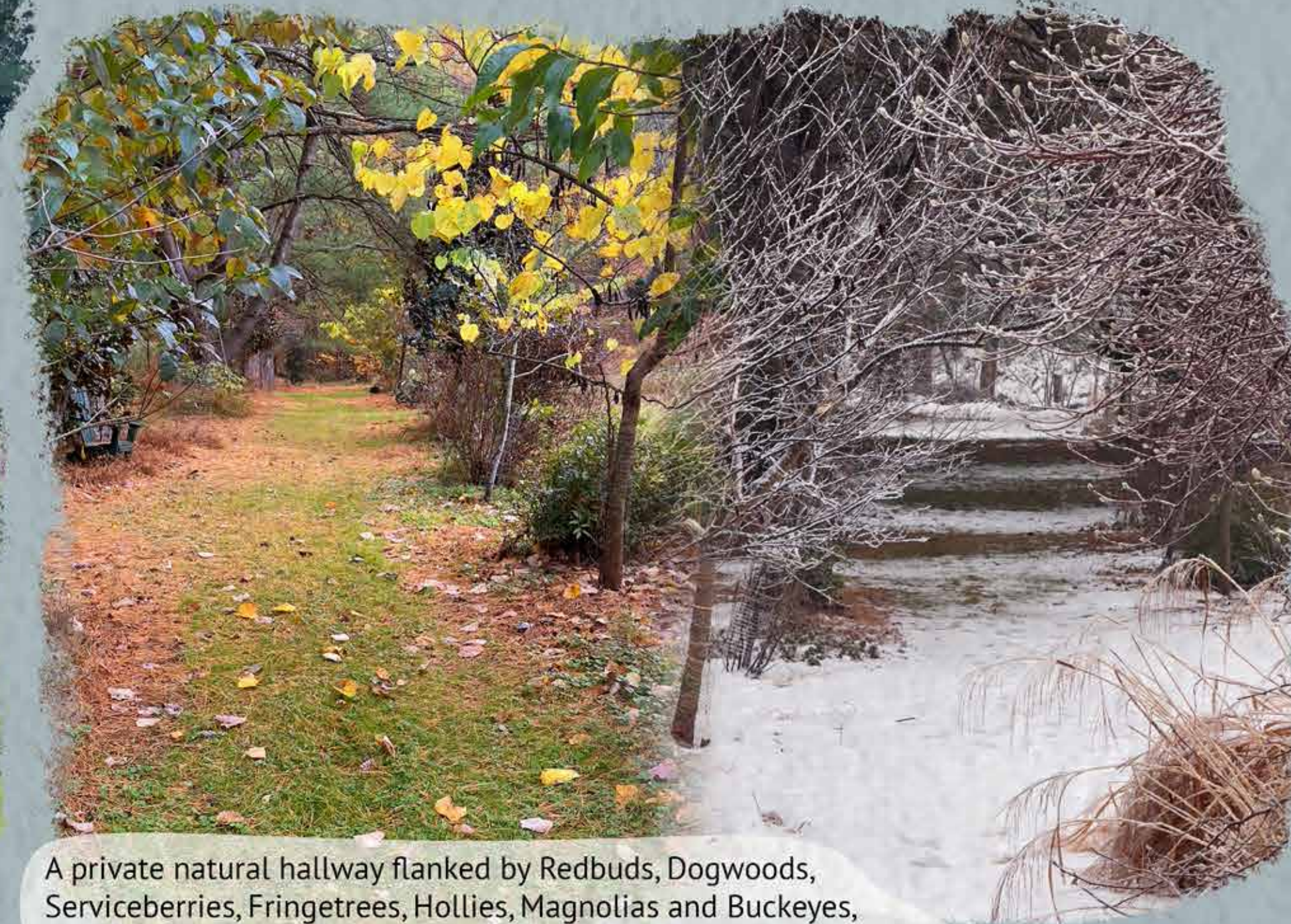

A unique resource for fishing in summer, skating in winter, keeping ducks for their eggs, and above all, for relaxing alone or with friends and family.

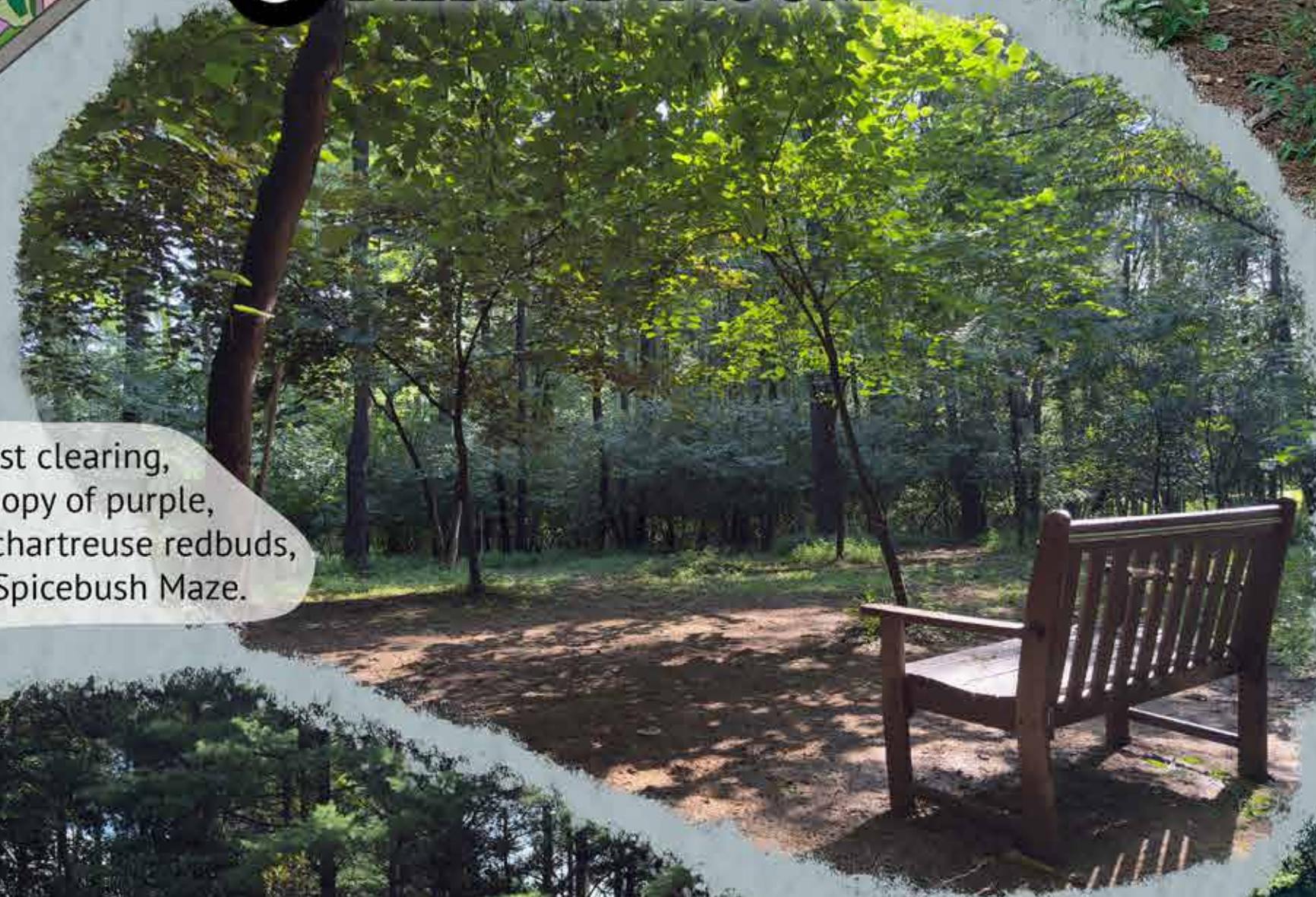
2 FROG SONG POND

Sit in a forest clearing, under a canopy of purple, green, and chartreuse redbuds, beside the Spicebush Maze.

6 PRAIRIE HALLWAYS

Tall native switchgrass form the walls of hallways that turn pale gold in winter.
